You can now distinguish your own home with an original painting of a cherished time in your life.






# WATERCOLOR

The watercolor medium has a magical ability to convey dramatic light and ethereal atmosphere. It's unruly behavior produces unpredictable and luminous effects not easily obtained with other mediums. Choose watercolor for a loose and romantic painting. Modern watercolor pigments produce art that is just as durable and lightfast as oil or acrylic pigments.

*Watercolor paintings should always be matted and framed under glass for protection.*

# ACRYLICS

Modern acrylic paints behave differently than oil paints. They do not like to blend as easily and can therefore yield sharper edged, higher contrast paintings, with a contemporary look and feel. Acrylic paint dries rapidly. This allows for spontaneous layering of paint. It can be applied using a palett knife to create highly textured impressionistic imagery.

Acrylic paintings can be completed, varnished and framed in short order if delivery schedule is an issue.

# OILS

Oil paints have been the predominant medium for many, many hundreds of years as they are both durable and versatile. Their ability to seamlessly blend with one another allows for incredibly soft and glowing gradations. They produce paintings with intense luminosity and chromatic brilliance. A finished oil painting generally requires a protective varnish coating to look its very best. An oil painting dries very slowly however and should not be varnished for at least six months or more. This important part of the process should be taken into consideration when deciding on the type of medium you would prefer.


## SELF TAUGHT

Photos are generally utilized as the basis for the painting. These can be existing photos if they are of suitable quality or from specially arranged photography. Figures can be placed into different scenes and paired with other figures for a custom design.

- All commissions require a 50% deposit before work can begin. Final balance due at transfer of art to customer.
- Pricing does not include shipping costs or shipping crate costs. These costs can be approximately determined prior to project start and added to agreement. ( Delivery is free within 50 miles of artist's Delaware studio)
- Artist retains right to determine if final art successfully meets the objectives of agreement between client and artist.
